Many people are surprised to find out that the Houston Nature Center is owned and operated by the City of Houston (population 979), with no ongoing County, State, or Federal support.

The Nature Center generates income each year through prairie seed and gift shop sales, camping and program fees, and donation jars. This income, while significant, falls far short of covering all yearly expenses.

The Friends of the Houston Nature Center, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, serves as the fundraising arm for the Houston Nature Center, Cash donations and donated items help us to keep the Natural Playground in good condition and to keep our summer programming going.
